- 2) Can also be met by COMM 113 (Introduction to Mass Communication) or PHIL 110 (Introduction to Critical Reasoning).
- 3) Can also be met by ENGL 271 (American Literature) or ENGL 311 (English Literature).
- 4) Must include one three-credit course in history or government and one course in psychology or sociology. Three of the following areas must be represented in the 11 credits: history, government, psychology, sociology, management-economics or anthropology.
- 5) A basic military science course may be substituted for one of the two physical education credits.
- 6) One course in physical science and one course in life science (one lab required).
- 7) A Bible book study to be chosen from BIBL 360-370.
- 8) All students must demonstrate mathematics proficiency in one of the following ways: pass Evangel's quantitative literacy exam; pass Advanced Placement statistics course; pass MATH 210, SOCI 210, GOVT 210, PSYC 210, SWK 210, MGMT 210, or COMM 210, and for education majors EDUC 434; pass course at another institution equivalent to one of the courses previously listed; or pass CLEP examination in statistics if available.
