The following conditions must be met at the time of application to be considered for admission into the BSN program at Cox:

- 1) math proficiency
- 2) science GPA ≥ 2.5
- 3) overall GPA ≥ 3.0 (for the 34 cr. listed in "5)" below)
- 4) no grades lower than a C-
- 5) at least 12 credits completed from this list of 34 credits (plus math proficiency)
 - a) Human A/P I (4 cr)
 - b) Human A/P II (4 cr)
 - c) Microbiology (4 cr)
 - d) Nutrition (3 cr)
 - e) Chemistry (4 cr)
 - f) Composition (3 cr)
 - g) Effective Communication (3 cr)
 - h) Intro. Psych (3 cr)
 - i) Nursing as a Profession (3 cr)
 - j) Lifespan Development (3 cr)

By the time classes start, all prerequisites listed above must be completed with no grades lower than a C-.

Of the courses ENGL 111, RHET 205, & ENGL 236, 2 courses (6 credits) must be completed to graduate. Which of these courses are required depends on ACT or similar test scores and proficiency exam results.

Math proficiency is required for entrance into the nursing program. Math proficiency can be obtained by having an ACT math score of 22+ (or SAT math score of 530+) OR completion of MATH 124 (intermediate algebra). If a student is not math proficient, MATH 124 should be taken in the first semester and BIOL 123 - Nutrition then should be taken in the summer.

EU math proficiency is completion of MATH 210 (or similar) - Statistics. MATH 210 (or similar) also is required for the nursing program. Statistics - MATH 210 (or similar) must be completed by the third semester of the nursing program.

National nursing accreditation requires that the American Government course (GOVT 170) must be taken in the state in which the nursing license is first issued; in our case the course must be taken in MO. It is an online course.

Pathophysiology must be taken before or during the first semester of the nursing program.
