

ASSISTANTSHIP/SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION & APPLICATION

Scholarships

Evangel University currently offers four Master of Education degrees: M.A. in Teaching, M.Ed. in Reading, M.Ed. in Educational Leadership, and M.Ed. in Secondary Teaching; an M.S. in School Counseling for public school counselors and a Master of Organizational Leadership.

Students from these programs can be awarded yearly scholarships in varying amounts if they qualify. Scholarships must be applied for each academic year. Awarding of scholarships is determined based on a combination of the following factors:

- Superior academic record
- Strong GRE/PRAXIS II scores
- Previous grants, published works, or professional presentations
- Involvement in professional organizations

In order to receive a scholarship, students must be full-time, degree-seeking students.

Assistantships

Evangel University currently offers two graduate degrees in Psychology: Master of Science in Clinical Psychology, Counseling Psychology and a Master of Science in School Counseling (specifically for public school guidance counseling). Most of the classes are offered in the evenings during the regular semesters and in summers.

Students in these programs can be awarded a variety of assistantships for both the first and second year of study. Typical assistantships require 10 hours of work per week and provide a 50% tuition reduction. There is no additional stipend. Assistantships must be renewed yearly.

Awarding of assistantships is determined based on a combination of the following factors:

- Superior academic record
- Strong GRE/MAT scores
- Previous grants, published works, or professional presentations
- Involvement in professional organizations

In order to receive a scholarship, students must be full-time, degree-seeking students.

Scholarship & Assistantship Application

All scholarship and assistantship applications should be received by February 15 for the following academic year.

Notification letters will be mailed in later half of March to those who have been awarded scholarships or assistantships.
