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Student Advising Contract

You and the university share responsibility for your education. Our most successful students assume this to ensure success through this process. At Evangel University, you have the freedom to make sound decisions about your academic career. With this freedom comes the need to be aware of your academic and administrative duties necessary to complete in order to graduate. You must take ownership in completing the required courses for your major in a four-year period.

You are expected to:

1. Take complete ownership of your degree. Understand that your advisor will not create your schedule or be responsible for your decisions to take the classes you choose. Your advisor will give you professional "advice" to help you attain your degree.
2. Supply your advisor your four-year plan to reach graduation based on the four-year degree sheet model. You are responsible for selecting the courses and course load each semester. You are responsible for passing the courses you select (all major courses require a grade of C- or higher).
3. Check regularly the remaining requirements for graduation. You are highly encouraged to take summer courses to reduce your regular semester course load.
4. Keep your advisor informed of situations that may disrupt your academic work. Consult your advisor immediately if a serious problem (medical, financial, personal) affects your ability to attend classes or interferes with your ability to focus on your education and to do your best academic work.
5. Set up your advising meeting with your advisor. Call to set an appointment with your advisor or complete the sign-up sheet. An email will notify you when the advising period will begin. It is your responsibility to check your Evangel email daily to be aware of such notices.
6. Be familiar with the academic calendar for such information as add/drop and withdrawal deadlines, registration dates, and final exam schedules.
7. Be aware of the degree requirements and all relevant policies outlined in the current catalog and on the Evangel website. If you do not understand a particular policy or requirement, ask your academic advisor to explain it to you.
8. Be proactive, plan ahead, and take advantage of the student resources at Evangel.
