**IMPORTANT NOTES**

1. Students with ACT English less than 26 or SAT Writing less than 590 need to gain proficiency before taking COMM 205 Effective Communication. Requirements are:
  - a. ACT English less than 19 or SAT Writing less than 460 = ENGL 102 (grade of A/B goes to COMM 205)
  - b. ACT English 20-23 or SAT Writing 470-540 = ENGL 111
  - c. ACT English 24-25 or SAT Writing 550-580 = take writing proficiency in first semester (pass goes to COMM 205; fail goes to ENGL 111)
2. To meet graduation requirement, students must meet sign up in the Maybee Center and meet proficiency requirements of the wellness program. *Athletes, ROTC, Veterans, and students who have taken Lifetime Fitness previously are exempt.*
3. EDUC 219 Foundations of Education and EDUC 220 Practicum must be taken concurrently.
4. EDUC 427, EDUC 437, and EDUC 476 are taken during student teaching semester.

**Students who did not complete high school in the United States will need to meet special requirements regarding composition and social science courses. See your advisor and State of Missouri requirements.**

**A Business Education major must maintain a cumulative average GPA of 2.700 and a GPA of 2.500 or higher in business courses. Passing scores must be earned in all sections of the C-BASE test.**

A Business emphasis for Elementary Education majors requires BUED 111 and 112 (classes or proficiency), 335, 337, and 496; ACCT 239, FIN 138, MRKT 239, ECON 212, and MGMT 235.
