CAMP DIRECTOR:

John Griffin is the Head Men's Soccer Coach at Evangel University. He is in his first year at EU, hired in June 2015 to take the helm of the men's soccer team. Prior to his arrival at Evangel, he was an assistant for both the men's and women's team at Culver-Stockton, helping both programs to their best seasons in more than a decade. The men's program won 11 games, the most at Culver-Stockton since 1999, and advanced to the Heart of America conference tournament championship game. Their women's team went 11-5-4 and also made it to the conference tournament championship game after qualifying for the league tournament for the first time in program history.

Griffin was as an assistant men's soccer coach at Milligan (Tenn.) in 2012 and 2013 and was part of their Appalachian Athletic Conference championship on 2012. He served as a high school head coach at Azle HS in Azle, Texas and worked as a graduate assistant coach at East Texas Baptist University. Griffin has also been a scout for Pensacola City FC in the National Premier Soccer League.

Griffin started his collegiate playing career at John Brown University in Siloam Springs, Arkansas before transferring to East Texas Baptist University. At ETBU, his team finished fourth in the NAIA in 1998 and won the National Christian College Athletic Association national championship the same season. Griffin was named to the NCCAA All-National Tournament team that year. He graduated from East Texas Baptist with a degree in History in 2001 and earned a Master's degree in History from the University of North Texas in 2012. Griffin also holds coaching licenses from the United State Soccer Federation.
