

## STEP FOUR | FILE THE FREE APPLICATION FOR FEDERAL STUDENT AID (FAFSA)

Evangel participates in all Title IV Federal Financial Aid Programs. File the FAFSA online at [fafsa.ed.gov](https://fafsa.ed.gov) or on the myStudentAid mobile application to access federal and state (MO) programs as well as Evangel need-based gift aid such as our Impact Grant and Multicultural Scholarship. When you file the FAFSA, you will be considered for the following grants and loans:

## STEP FIVE | APPLY FOR OUTSIDE SCHOLARSHIPS

Search for outside scholarships using search engines such as FastWeb.com, CollegeScholarships.com, and CollegeExpress.com. See our full list of recommended search engines online at [evangel.edu/outsidescholarships](https://evangel.edu/outsidescholarships). We recommend applying for outside scholarships all four years while you are in college.

## STEP SIX | ENROLL IN OUR FLEXIBLE MONTHLY PAYMENT PLAN

Manage any remaining balance after aid and reduce or eliminate borrowing with Evangel's Flexible Monthly Payment Plan. This convenient option allows you to make up to six payments per semester when you begin your payment plan in June for the fall semester and December for the spring semester. Enrollment in the plan is only \$50 per semester and no interest is charged. Enroll through your Student Portal when financial registration opens in June.

## STEP ONE | DISCOVER YOUR ACADEMIC SCHOLARSHIP

Upon admission, the first notice you will receive after your acceptance letter is your academic scholarship offer. Use the charts below to determine your scholarship level.

### FIRST-TIME STUDENTS

The following academic awards are determined based on a combination of test score and high school GPA.

\$12,000 SCHOLARS AWARD
\$11,000 DISTINCTION AWARD
\$9,000 EXCELLENCE AWARD
\$8,000 HERITAGE AWARD
\$7,000 PROMISE AWARD

### FIRST-TIME STUDENTS—FOUNDERS SCHOLARSHIP

First time students with a 3.5 GPA and 24 ACT, 1160 SAT, or 76 CLT are invited to apply for EU's Founders Scholarship. This premier academic scholarship replaces your academic scholarship with awards ranging from \$13,000 to \$25,000. Required interviews are held in December, January, and February. ### FIRST-TIME TEST-OPTIONAL AND TRANSFER STUDENTS

The following awards are determined on high school or college GPA only. These awards apply to first-time high school students who apply through our test-optional program and to college transfer students.

\$10,000 EXCELLENCE AWARD	3.6 or higher GPA
\$9,000 HERITAGE AWARD	3.4 to 3.59 GPA
\$8,000 HERITAGE AWARD	3.0 to 3.39 GPA
\$7,000 PROMISE AWARD	2.6 to 2.99 GPA
\$6,000 PROMISE AWARD	2.5 to 2.59 High School GPA <i>(Test-optional students only)</i> College transfer students are considered for this award based upon a comprehensive review of the application.

## STEP TWO | PURSUE A TALENT SCHOLARSHIP

Do you have a special talent or ability? Put your skill to work with one of our talent awards. Talent scholarships are available in athletics or in fine arts. Applicants are only eligible for one talent scholarship. Our recommendation? Pursue your scholarship in the area in which you are most passionate and skilled. Then, participate in other areas for an enriching college experience.

Awards generally range from \$1,000 to \$3,000 for students majoring or minoring in a fine arts area. Eligible degree programs include:

#### PERFORMANCE/SELECTION AWARDS – Open to all students *(\$500 to \$2,000 per year.)*

Performance/selection awards cannot be combined with major/minor awards or athletic scholarships. Apply early for best consideration. Some positions are limited.
