Evangel University's **School Psychological Examiner Certification** equips you to work with K-12 public school students. You will be trained to competently administer, score, and interpret **standardized test instruments** as well as to write up reports when determining students' eligibilities for specialized services. This certification is an add-on to an existing master's degree that satisfies teaching or student services certification from the Missouri Department of Elementary and Secondary Education (DESE), such as a master's degree in School Counseling or Education. Those with psychology degrees qualify if they have a teaching or student services certificate on file with DESE. Graduate students receive:

- Outstanding instruction and mentoring by highly experienced faculty
- Hands-on training during classes as well as through a 150-hour practicum
- ► Eligibility to obtain DESE School Psychological Examiner Certification upon completion
- Some students are able to complete certification by completing a minimum of three classes in addition to their existing master's degree courses

Prerequisites:

- Valid teaching or student services certificate
- Master's degree in Counseling Psychology, Educational Psychology, School Counseling, or Education
- ▲ Course in psychology or education of the exceptional child (minimum of two credit hours)

Starts: New cohorts begin each summer

Format: Typically one seated course each semester

Tuition: \$400 per credit for 2018-2019
