



2022-2023 TEACH Grant Application

The Federal Teacher Education Assistance for College and Higher Education (TEACH) Grant is awarded through the Evangel University Office of Financial Aid to students who are completing coursework that is necessary to begin a career teaching in a qualified subject area and who agree to serve for a minimum of four (4) years as a full-time, highly-qualified teacher in a school that serves low-income students.

Students awarded the TEACH Grant are required to complete four years (4) of qualified teaching service within eight (8) years of completing their course of study for which the TEACH Grant was awarded. Failure to meet this or any other requirement of the TEACH Grant will result in the grant converting to a Federal Direct Unsubsidized Loan, with interest accrued and capitalized from the date of original grant disbursement.

To apply for the TEACH Grant:

- Complete a 2022-2023 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) at www.fafsa.gov
- Be a U.S. citizen or eligible non-citizen.
- Be accepted into the Evangel Teacher Education Program, which usually occurs during the sophomore year.
- Be a degree-seeking undergraduate student pursuing their first bachelors
- Be a degree-seeking graduate student pursuing their first masters. Prerequisite undergraduate courses are not eligible for TEACH Grant funds.
- Enroll in coursework necessary to complete a teacher certification in a high-need field.
- Maintain a cumulative GPA of at least 3.25 each semester.
- Sign a TEACH Grant Agreement to Serve.
- Complete the online Entrance Counseling and subsequent counseling with Evangel's Education Department as well as Office of Financial Aid.

TEACH Grant Award Amounts:**

Undergraduates: \$4,000 maximum per year (up to an aggregate amount of \$16,000)

Graduates: \$4,000 maximum per year (up to an aggregate amount of \$8,000)

\$4,000 per year for full-time enrollment

\$3,000 per year for three-quarter-time enrollment

\$2,000 per year for half-time enrollment

\$1,000 per year for less than half-time enrollment

***For any 2021–22 TEACH Grant first disbursed on or after Oct. 1, 2020, and before Oct. 1, 2021, the maximum award of \$4,000 is reduced by 5.7 percent (\$228), resulting in a maximum award of \$3,772.*

To fulfill the TEACH Grant Agreement to Serve Requirements, a recipient must:

- Serve as a full-time highly qualified teacher in a low-income school in a high-need field as listed in the Nationwide List for the state in which you will be teaching the majority of classes for at least four (4) years within eight (8) calendar years of leaving the program for which you received the TEACH Grant. High-Need fields are these specific fields: bilingual education and English Language Acquisition, foreign language, mathematics, reading specialist, science, and special education. - Write to the Secretary of Education (within 120 days of completing or otherwise leaving the program of study for which the TEACH Grant was received) confirming that you are employed as a full-time teacher in accordance with the terms of the TEACH Grant, or you are not yet employed as a full-time teacher but intend to meet the terms of the TEACH Grant service agreement.
- Respond promptly to any requests for information or documentation from the U.S. Department of Education.
- Submit upon completion of each year of teaching service, documentation of the service in the form of a certification by a chief administrative officer of the school.
- Comply with all other terms, conditions, and requirements that the Secretary of Education determines to be necessary.

Failing to meet any of the terms above will result in the TEACH Grant funds you received converting into a Federal Direct Unsubsidized Loan, with interest accrued and capitalized from the date of original TEACH Grant disbursement(s). Once this grant converts to a loan, it cannot be converted back to a grant.

If you are interested in being considered for the TEACH Grant, complete the following application and return it to Office of Financial Aid for review and processing. **Incomplete applications cannot be processed.**

Conditions of the TEACH Grant

By signing this form, I am certifying that I have read this form and all enclosures thoroughly. I understand that by signing and submitting this form, I am requesting the Office of Financial Aid to determine my eligibility for the TEACH Grant and, if it is determined that I am eligible, to add the grant to my award package. The TEACH Grant in conjunction with other forms of financial aid cannot exceed the cost of attendance. The Grant amount disbursed will be based on my enrollment status following the census date of each semester. I understand that I will be ineligible for the Grant if my cumulative GPA is not at least 3.25 each semester.

IMPORTANT: If you fail to complete the service obligation, all TEACH Grant funds that you received will be converted to a Federal Direct Unsubsidized Loan. You must then repay this loan to the U.S. Department of Education. You will be charged interest from the date the grant(s) was disbursed to your student account.
