

Bachelor of Arts or Bachelor of Science in Education

Pre-service teachers must take two credentialing exams, Missouri Content Assessment and, Missouri Performance Teacher Assessment, in order to apply for teacher certification in Missouri.

Completion rates are calculated by determining how long it takes students to complete their degree from their initial start date. The percentage for a given year is an aggregate of the percentage of those who graduated the previous year plus those who graduated for the current year.

Similar to completion rates, retention rates are calculated over a five year period. Retention rates are calculated based on the aggregate number of withdrawn students subtracted from a specific start date (cohort) divided by the original number of students enrolled at the same start date.
