

Master of Science in Athletic Training

Healthcare professionals seeking the credentialing of an Athletic Trainer must graduate from a CAATE accredited athletic training program. At that time, students are eligible to sit for the Board of Certification © exam (BOC). Upon passing the Board of Certification exam and any other state specific credentialing exams, professionals are eligible for licensure or registration in the state in which they are seeking employment.

The Evangel University College of Adult and Graduate Studies requires masters' degrees to be completed within a five-year time frame. Student data is required to stay within the cohort in which the student entered the program. For example, if a student entered the program in the 2016-17 year, but did not graduate until the Spring of 2020, the student's data would be added to the 2016-17 cohort graduation data. CAATE requires programs to maintain a three year aggregate BOC pass rate of 70% or higher.

Retention rates are calculated over a five year period. Retention rates are calculated based on the aggregate number of withdrawn students subtracted from a specific start date (cohort) divided by the original number of students enrolled at the same start date.

The numbers below are reflective of the undergraduate athletic training program. The graduate athletic training program will admit it's first cohort in the summer of 2018.
