Awarded the Times of London Book of the Year for his work *Signature in the Cell: DNA and the Evidence for Intelligent Design*.

Chief Executive Officer at Hope and Healing Center & Institute in Houston, TX. Former professor of psychology, neuroscience and biomedical studies at Baylor University. DR. HUGH ROSS

Ph.D. — University of Toronto
"The Age of Creation"

Founder of Reason to Believe (RTB) an organization that aims to highlight the connection between science and biblical faith. Author of many best-selling books including *Navigating Genesis*, *Hidden Treasures in the book of Job*, and *Why the Universe Is the Way It Is*. Dr. Ross has also spoke at 300 universities, 400 churches, and multiple conferences.

DR. JAMES BRADFORD

Ph.D. — University of Minnesota
"Some Pastoral Perspectives of Faith and Science"

Has a degree in aerospace engineering and is also one of the top four officials in the Assemblies of God. He was elected General Secretary in 2009, and oversees credentialing of ministers, church chartering, collection of official statistics, and the Flower Pentecostal Heritage Center. It was under the leadership of Dr. Bradford that the inaugural Faith and Science Conference took place in summer 2011.

Ph.D. — Boston University

Amos Yong is Professor of Theology and Missions and director of the Center for Missiological Research at Fuller Theological Seminary in Pasadena, California. His graduate education includes degrees in theology, history, and religious studies from Western Evangelical Seminary (now George Fox Seminary) and Portland State University, Portland, Oregon, and Boston University, Boston, Massachusetts, and an undergraduate degree from Bethany University of the Assemblies of God. He has authored or edited over three dozen volumes.
