

Evangel holds Articulation Agreements with the following institutions. Please refer to the Academic Catalog for complete information about these programs.

Alphacrucis College - July 17, 2015

Students completing the Bachelor of Ministry or Bachelor of Theology degree at Alphacrucis College will be granted direct entry into the Master of Divinity, Master of Pastoral Leadership, Master of Arts in Christian Ministries, Master of Arts in Intercultural Studies, Master of Arts in Theological Studies, or Master of Organizational leadership at Evangel University.

Centro de Investigaciones Culturales y Estudios Lingüísticos (CINCEL), Spanish Language Institute, San Jose, Costa Rica – December 15, 2010

AGTS will deliver 6 courses per year toward the Master of Arts in Christian Ministries degree. Courses completed at CINCEL will apply to AGTS degrees.

Continental Theological Seminary (CTS), Brussels, Belgium – March 19, 2014

AGTS will deliver four intercultural studies courses on the Continental Theological Seminary. Courses completed at CTS will apply to either CTS or AGTS degrees.

Lester E. Cox Medical Centers - June 1, 2010

Cox Hospitals serve as clinical and/or practicum sites for Evangel health care students.

Cox College – April 15, 2009

Students who meet requirements earn the Cox College Bachelor of Science in Nursing and Evangel University Bachelor of Science in Health Care concurrently.

Jacques Lefevre Institute – October 25, 2007

Study abroad opportunities in France for up to 25% of a degree program.

Missouri State University – July 28, 2006

Opportunities to earn an accelerated master's degree; Evangel juniors and seniors may apply approved 300 or 400 level courses toward a master's degree at Missouri State University

Ozarks Technical Community College – January 1, 2005

Graduates of OTC may enter Evangel Professional Studies program at junior status. 60 credits will apply toward baccalaureate degree at Evangel.

Southwest Baptist University – October 20, 2014

Evangel graduates with any baccalaureate degree, who meet admission requirements to the Doctor of Physical Therapy Program at Southwest Baptist University will automatically receive preference points and be eligible for the admission process.
