

Health Care/Nursing

Evangel's Nursing program is a cooperative effort with Missouri State University through The Alliance for Healthcare Education. Students earn two bachelor's degrees: a B.S. in Health Care from Evangel and a B.S. in Nursing from Missouri State University. This is an all-inclusive, fully accredited, 4-year program.

EU students live on campus and participate in Evangel student life. Students complete nursing prerequisite courses and nearly all core curriculum requirements during the first four semesters. During the last four semesters, students take courses in nursing theory at the Alliance campus and complete clinical work through the Cox Health Systems network. The B.S. in Nursing requirements must be met before students receive the B.S. in Health Care. When they complete the program, students are eligible to take and pass the NCLEX exam which qualifies them for licensure as Registered Nurses.

Suggested Course Sequencing: 17-18 credits per semester; however, taking summer courses will reduce semester hours.

ACT English \geq 26 or SAT Writing/Language (W/L) \geq 33, CLT Writing/Grammar (W/G) \geq 32: student still needs ENGL 111 to meet nursing requirements.

If transfer student has ENGL 111 composition only: enroll in ENGL 205 and COMM 211.

If transfer student has a 200-level (or above) composition course only: enroll in ENGL 111 and COMM 211.

If transfer student has a 100-level composition course AND a 200-level composition course AND a speech course: student is proficient.

If student has no test scores: enroll in ENGL 102 and schedule ACCUPLACER exam.

Minimum total credits to graduate 124

The following conditions must be met at the time of application to be considered for admission into the BSN program at Missouri State University:

- 1) overall GPA \geq 3.0, 2) no grades lower than a C-, 3) completion of online application, 4) submission of resume (paid healthcare experience is highly valued!), and 5) submission of virtual interview. By the time a student starts the nursing program, all EU classes must be completed except FIN 138, BIBL 360-379, ICST 454, and THEO 320.
