BIBL Exegesis	Competence in Biblical Interpretation - Biblical studies majors will be able to interpret texts of the Hebrew or Greek Bible and produce scholarly exegetical presentations in written or oral formats.	B1
BIBL Concepts	Competence in Basic Theological Concepts - Majors will develop a knowledge base of the discipline of theology and be able to express theological ideas in a cogent manner that is in keeping with academic study.	B2
BIBL Philosophy	Competence in Philosophy - Students will be able to express philosophical ideas in a cogent manner that is in keeping with academic study. Moreover, students will demonstrate critical thinking skills that will enable them to dedicate themselves to the Christian way of life in their chosen vocation.	B3
