The following Program Learning Outcomes have been established by Evangel faculty to define the areas of knowledge and skills that students graduating from this major degree program should have developed.

- 1. Students will use critical thinking skills and knowledge based on scientific inquiry in the application of the problem-solving process with multilevel client systems within a strengths-based person-in-the-environment framework.
- 2. Students will have an understanding and respect for various forms of diversity and special populations and apply strategies for effective practice.
- 3. Students will demonstrate commitment to advocate for social and economic justice and human rights in the delivery of preventative services, interventions, and policy practice.
- 4. Students will demonstrate ethical practice through self-awareness, life-long learning, and professional leadership.
- 5. Within the context of a faith based liberal arts institution, students will impact campus awareness surrounding social issues such as poverty and social injustice.
