[3] EDUC 421, 497 must be taken concurrently the last semester before student teaching. [Field Exp. Placement Form Req.] Ideally, COMJ 336 is taken concurrently with EDUC 497.

[4] EDUC 427, 437 must be taken during student teaching semester.
