The application calls for a personal statement explaining why you are a good candidate to receive a scholarship. Please feel free to attach additional information or documents to the application.

Scholarships are awarded on:

1. Academic performance (GPA, awards, research, service)
2. Financial need
3. Leadership – i.e. professional activity, volunteer
4. Full time enrollment
