Evangel University's **Master of Science in School Counseling** prepares students to become professional school counselors with the skills required to design, implement, evaluate and continuously improve a comprehensive school counseling program that **promotes** and **enhances student success**.

- ▶ Prepares students for counseling roles in public and private school communities.
- ▶ Completion of coursework satisfies specific course requirements for certification as a school counselor & licensure as a **Licensed Professional Counselor (LPC)** in Missouri.
- ▶ Graduates may pursue Missouri certification as a **School Psychological Examiner**.

## **Prerequisites:**

- ▶ Baccalaureate degree with a 3.0 GPA
- ▶ Nine credits in psychology
- ▶ Three credits in statistics with a grade of B- or higher

**Next program start:** August 2018 (application deadline is July 1, 2018)

**Program format:** on-campus late afternoons and evenings plus practicum and internships

**Credits:** 60 credits, year-round program typically completed in two years

**Tuition:** \$400 per credit for 2018-2019

Three References, Resume, APA Writing Sample, Statement of Purpose, Interview, \$25 Application Fee, and Background Check (*Required for Practicums and Internships*).
