FINANCIAL AID CHECKLIST

- Review your financial aid award letter (enclosed). Contact your financial aid counselor if you have any questions.
- Follow the link to **My Financial Aid** on our website: www.evangel.edu/financial
 - a. Use your Evangel University username and password to login.
- Go to **Menu** ≡ → **Accept Awards**
 - a. Accept or decline each award listed.
 - b. If you do not want to accept the full amount of a loan offered, you can decrease the value and accept a lower amount.
 - c. Remember to check the "Messages" for important information about your awards.
- Select **Menu** ≡ → **Documents**, complete any *missing* or *incomplete* documents.
Federal Direct Loan Entrance Counseling and a Federal Direct Master Promissory Note (MPN)
- Notify financial aid counselor of any additional aid you will receive not listed on your award package. Provide a copy of outside scholarship awards from scholarship committee including your name and scholarship amount.
- Ask your church about a Church Matching Scholarship. (Evangel University will match up to \$500 (\$250 per term). Application at evangel.edu/financial/scholarships.)
- Search for outside scholarships.
- Apply at HireEvangel.com if you want to work on campus.
- Apply for private and endowed scholarships in your student portal under Money. Deadline to apply January 31.
- Notify your financial aid counselor if your enrollment or housing plans change. Awards are based on full time enrollment.
- Monitor your Evangel student e-mail and your My Financial Aid Portal for future financial aid communications.
- Finalize payment options for your estimated remaining balance. Payment is due prior to the start of each term. In addition to traditional payment methods, the following programs are also available.
 - a. No Interest Payment Plan: 4-6 payments per semester (number of payments available based on date of first payment) - \$50 fee per term (on remaining balance after financial aid).
This option will be made available to you during the online financial registration process.
- The Bursar's office is available to help you manage your payment plan. Contact their office at 417.865.2815 Ext. 7700.
 - b. Additional Student Loan Options (If using the loan options below apply 2-4 weeks prior to the date you want to financially register to allow processing time):

- Federal Parent PLUS Loan application available at www.studentloans.gov
- Review student bill from Bursar's office, select payment option, sign Financial Responsibility Agreement and make your first payment when you receive notice that financial registration is open.
