BIOL 124 Human Biology w/Lab Explains the physiology and anatomy of the human body. Topics include a unit on origins and bioethics. Lab is required. Course has weekly due dates. See the Evangel Bookstore for required textbooks.	ODE 1 w/ LAB ODE 52	4	\$260
CPSC 101 Introduction to Personal Computers Survey of personal computers and applications. Introduces general computer concepts and terminology with emphasis on using the personal computer as a tool for knowledge workers. Popular software applications examined include word processing, data management, electronic spreadsheets, and computer graphics. Course has weekly due dates. MATH 210 Elementary Statistics Descriptive statistics including univariate, bivariate, and multivariate data; binomial and normal probability distributions; and confidence intervals, parametric, and non-parametric hypothesis tests. Uses a statistical software package such as SPSS. Satisfies mathematics proficiency requirements. Course has weekly due dates. See the Evangel Bookstore for required textbooks.	ODE 1	3	\$195
MATH 231 Calculus I Introduction to the concepts of calculus, including coordinate systems, curve analysis, derivatives and differentials, time-related changes, maxima and minima, integration, and related topics. Course Prerequisites: Math 129, ACT 24+, SAT 570+, or permission of professor. Course has weekly due dates. See the Evangel Bookstore for required textbooks.	ODE 1	4	\$260
