Unaccompanied: When a student is not living in the physical custody of a parent or guardian

Homeless: lacking fixed, regular, and adequate housing (includes living in shelters, motels, cars, or temporarily living with people because you had nowhere else to go)

At risk of being homeless: when a student's housing may cease to be fixed, regular, and adequate (i.e. A student who is being evicted or has been asked to leave their current residence and has been unable to find fixed, regular, and adequate housing.)

Self-supporting: when a student pays for his or her own living expenses, which includes paying for fixed, regular, and adequate housing. (Student must be self-supporting and at risk of homelessness.)

Unaccompanied youth: as of the day you signed the financial aid application you were not living in the physical custody of your parent or guardian AND you are 21 years of age or younger or you were still enrolled in high school.
