

Accelerated Pathway (Summer Start Only)

Clinical MH Counseling

Requirements for participation in the Accelerated Pathway:

1. Students will apply to the accelerated pathway at the end of Summer 1. They must have true A's (94 or above) in both summer courses and no late work submissions.
2. Students cannot be employed more than 25 hours per week to apply. Each student will be required to submit a Master Weekly Schedule template as part of the application process.
3. After the first fall semester students cannot have any grades lower than A-, cannot earn a zero on any KPI, and have no late work to continue in the accelerated pathway and move to Practicum. They will be reviewed for candidacy at the beginning of December to begin practicum in Spring. If they do not pass candidacy, they will not continue in the accelerated pathway. Additionally, each semester the student must maintain a 3.5 GPA and obtain at least a 1 on all KPIs or they will be returned to the regular 3-year course progression in the next semester.
