



Graduate Counseling Admission Process

Applicants must meet the following minimum requirements to be considered for admission to the graduate counseling programs at Evangel University:

1. A completed bachelor's degree from an accredited institution
2. An undergraduate GPA of at least 3.0 or a GRE combined score of 290 or higher
3. At least 6 credit hours of psychology or counseling coursework

The following actions are required to complete the [admissions application](#):

1. Complete the general information sections of the application
2. Provide the names and emails of 3 people who can complete an online recommendation form
3. Submit an essay responding to the prompt on the application
4. Upload a 5-page (or more) APA writing sample with multiple citations and a reference page. The paper can be a previous undergraduate assignment as long as it was not a group effort.
5. Request an official transcript from the accredited institution at which a bachelor's degree was completed (sent directly to Evangel University at OGSSadmissions@evangel.edu)
6. Order a background check via *Choice Screening* (fees vary by state) and submit a copy of the order receipt.

Completed applicants who meet the minimum requirements will be invited for an interview with a committee of faculty. Upon completion of the interview and evaluation by the faculty, applicants will be notified of the admission decision.

An invitation for admission is based upon the quality of the application materials combined with the quality of the interview. For more information, see the [Program Handbook](#).
