ACT English \geq 26 or SAT Writing/Language (W/L) \geq 33, CLT Writing/Grammar (W/G) \geq 32, Accuplacer \geq 263: Student is proficient. Enroll in Effective Communication option. Refer to each term's "Core Options" document for available choices.

If transfer student has ENGL 111 composition only, enroll in a 200-300 level Effective Communication course.

If transfer student has a 200-300 level (or above) composition course, check for Speech course. If no Speech listed, enroll in COMM 211.
